The Chapter voted to move the meeting date to 7:00 pm on the 2nd Monday of each month. We will talk about the possibility of a Saturday meeting next month.


We approved Mount Pleasant, Texas as the Headquarters location for our Chapter, along with Vera Bank as our bank and P.O. Box 1861 as our address.
