Lucy Phelps was born in 1761 in Buckingham Co, VA, the fourth of eight children born to Thomas Phelps and Sarah "Susannah" Guy.

Lucy Phelps was present at the Siege of Boonesborough along with her father Thomas and several of her brothers. She is recognized as a Defender of Forts and Frontiers. She was reported to have been the one to sound the alarm that the In 1840, Lucy returned to Madison Co, Ky for the great celebration at Boonesborough and was recognized as one of the few survivors of the original garrison. She was too ill to make the trip home and died in Madison County. About 1780 Lucy married Marsham Brashear at Bear Grass (now Louisville) in what is considered the first wedding between whites in this area.
