COLLECTING DUES

It is the responsibility of the Chapter Adjutant to collect all dues for his chapter. This includes the Chapter Dues (set by Chapter), the Texas State Society Dues (\$10.00) and the National Dues (\$45.00). These dues must be listed and shown by member with their member number. Deposit the money in your Chapter's bank account.

With one check (made to the Texas Society MOS&B) and the list of paid members, forward accumulated Texas Society State Dues to David P. McMahon, P. O. Box 3311, San Angelo, TX 76902-3311. Write another check and with the list, send the accumulated National Dues to the MOS&B Adjutant at MOS&B IHQ, P.O. Box 18901, Raleigh, NC 27619-8901.

Dues are to be received and registered by not later than the 31st of December for the following year or they are considered delinquent. Please do not have your members send their dues in to State or National as individuals as this creates undue and excessive work and does not allow you to know for sure which of your members are active.

It should be noted that even the Life Members need to pay Texas Society Dues of \$10. A Life Membership is with National and no National Dues would be collected. However, there are no Texas Society Lifetime Memberships, therefore, to stay active in the Society, dues must be paid.
